Requirements:

Behind the Scenes

- Need not be available for camp or training sessions. All advance behind the scenes only.

Counselor-in-Training

- Is a rising 7th or 8th grade student, from any school
- Is available to volunteer for full camp: Monday-Friday, July 10-14, 8:30am-12:30pm
- Attends at least one training session (June 15 or June 25 from 6:30-8pm)
- Follows professional conduct in working with children

Junior Counselor

- Is a rising 9th or 10th grade student from any school
- Meets all requirements of counselors-in-training
- Provides one recommendation (from teachers, employers, neighbors, family friends, etc.)

Senior Counselor

- Is a rising 11th or 12th grade student from any school
- Meets all requirements of Junior Counselors
- Provides two recommendations (from teachers, employers, neighbors, family friends, etc.)
- Conducts a brief 15-minute interview with Parish Religious Education staff member
