Fasting is not an obligation for those with a medical condition which would be made worse by fasting.







Your generous donations for the poor at our Masses help The Society of Saint Vincent de Paul at Holy Spirit support our neighbors in need. Neighbors like a Holy Spirit parishioner who was widowed in

2022. Her husband worked in low paying jobs, and she had sold home-made meals to neighbors to make ends meet. After his passing, funeral costs wiped out any savings they had. With the help of her community and SVdP she got back on her feet. At the time we helped her with rent and utilities. She managed to do okay over the past year, with the

support of her adult children. But, over the past few months, meal sales dropped, her children have struggled to find work themselves, and rent went up. In February, our volunteers were there again to help her with her rent, utilities, prayers and an Aldi's gift card that she can use for food for herself as well as supplies for delicious meals she can sell.
