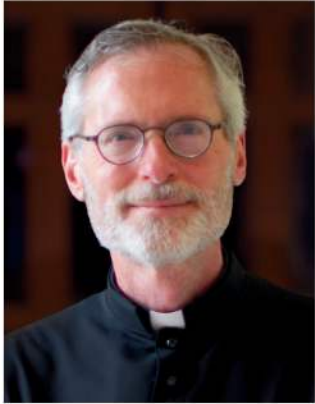

Over the next couple of weeks, we will post safety signage and share any changes to Memorial Garden visiting hours during construction. We will also keep parishioners updated once the livestream is available to watch the build in progress.

As a reminder, the Founding Reservation Period for reserving a Columbarium niche ends August 31. **Niche pricing will increase from \$6,000 to \$7,000 on September 1 when Construction Pricing begins.**

The Archdiocese of Atlanta is shifting the celebration of Confirmation to the middle school years in order to better accompany young people and their families during this formative stage of faith development.

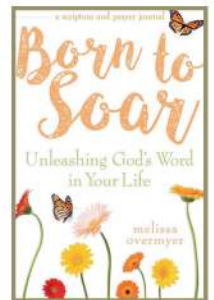

Ejercicio de la semana
