## Monthly Wednesday Night Dinners Resume September 10

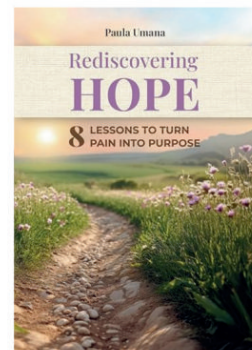

## Support Our Priests Through the Seven Sisters Apostolate

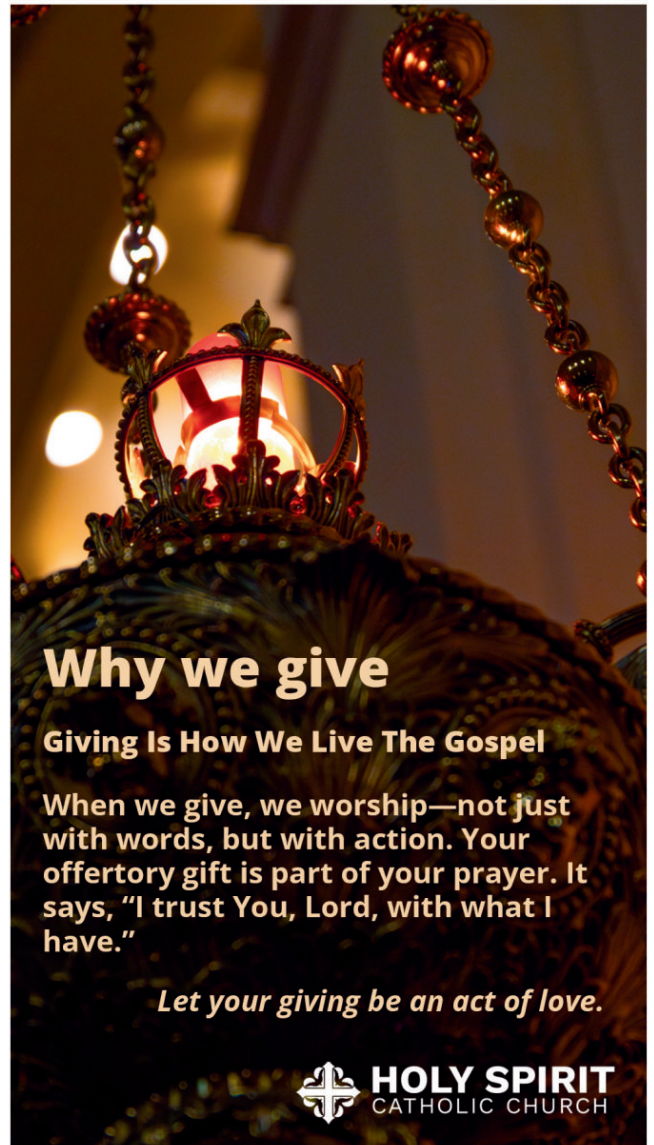

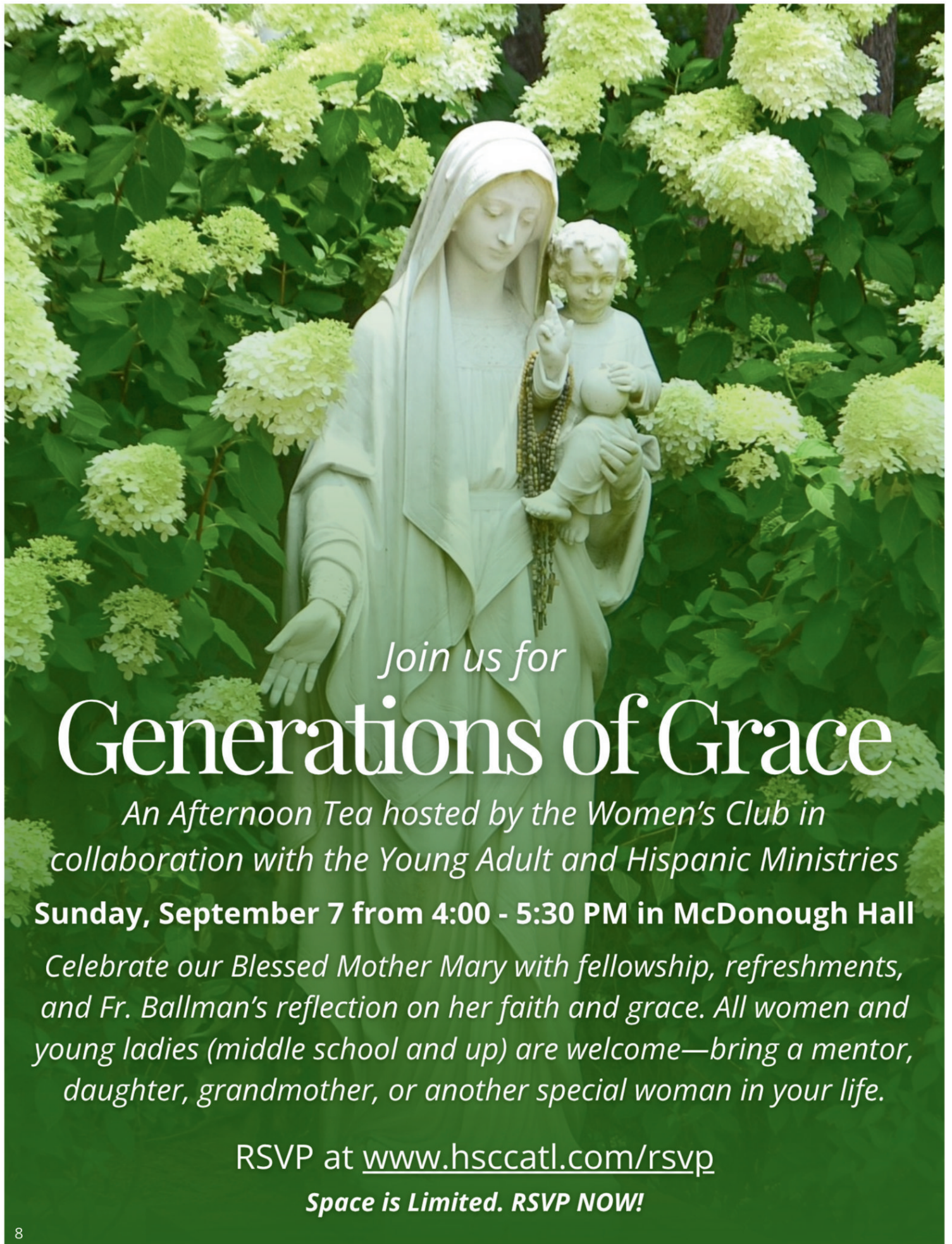

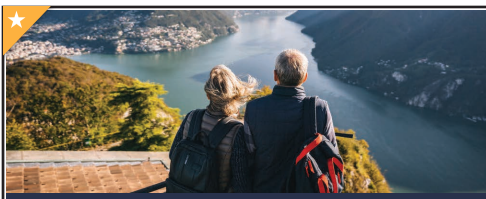
