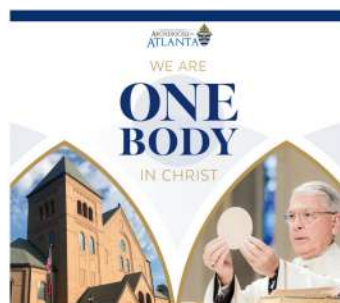

## Author or Text? Rethinking How We View Literature

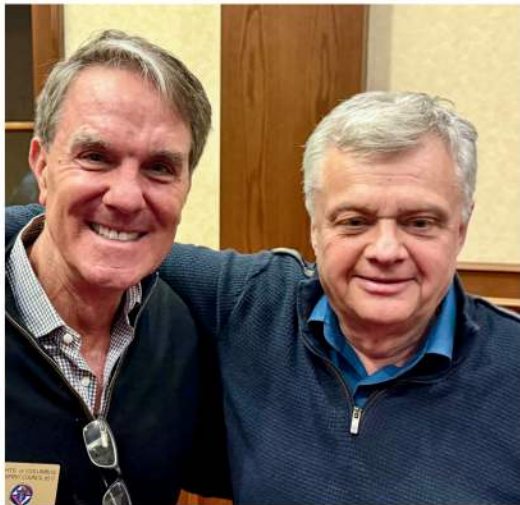
For recent centuries, historians and critics have considered literature as one of the defining products of a culture. But how should we read and interpret the literary work?

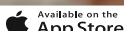

### Reflexión de la semana:
