
Monday, January 8 - Incorporating Spirituality into One's Wellness Routine.

Thorstein Veblen (1857-1929) was an American economist and sociologist who became a well known critic of capitalism. In his best-known work, *The Theory of the Leisure Class*, the terms "conspicuous consumption" and "conspicuous leisure" were coined. Published in 1899 at the height of the rise of the *robber barons*, the book points out that the pursuit of profits and the making of useful goods are incompatible. We will discuss selections from Chapters 1 and 4, which include the topic of conspicuous consumption.


