The theme of equality has long played a central role in political thought and continues to shape many political debates. Questions about what equality is—and what it should be—are woven throughout differing political philosophies and positions. Friedrich A. Hayek (1899–1992), in *Equality, Value, and Merit*, and Ronald Dworkin (1931–2013), in *Liberalism*, present contrasting perspectives on this important theme. 
