

Estos exámenes cuestan regularmente, en los hospitales, entre \$500 a \$1,200 cada uno, Stroke Scan los ofrecerá por una fracción del costo Como cortesía, junto con el Paquete Vascular, también se examinarán la tiroides, hígado, vesícula y riñones, sin ningún costo adicional.
