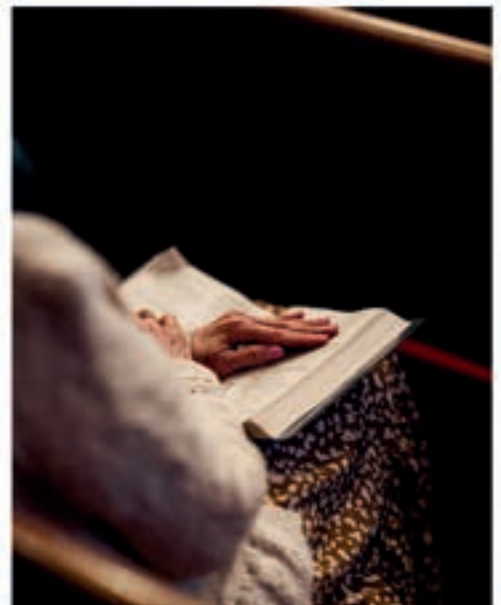

Acclaimed Sculptor Timothy Schmalz to Showcase Renderings for Expanded Memorial Garden THIS Tuesday, June 9

Holy Spirit is excited to announce that internationally acclaimed sculptor Timothy Schmalz has been commissioned to create several pieces of art for the expansion of our Memorial Garden. Many parishioners may recall that in January 2022, we hosted a replica of the *Angels Unawares* sculpture which is permanently installed at Catholic University of America in Washington, DC (the original piece is in St. Peter's Square at the Vatican). Some of Mr. Schmalz's other notable pieces include *Homeless Jesus*, which is installed in several places, including St. Peter's Square, New York City, and Toronto, and *Gospel Garden / Stations of the Cross* located at Mary Queen of the Universe Basilica in Orlando.

Mr. Schmalz will unveil his renderings for our Memorial Garden expansion during a special presentation on Tuesday, June 9, from 6:30 PM - 8:00 PM in McDonough Hall. For the Vincentians of Holy Spirit and the 76 Society of St. Vincent de Paul Georgia conferences across Georgia, these stories feel deeply familiar. In our home visits, we meet families every week who are working full-time yet still struggling to afford stable housing.

Together—with your collections to the poor, the compassion of local Vincentians and SVdP Georgia's statewide programs—we helped prevent more than 10,000 evictions across Georgia last year, making St. Vincent de Paul Georgia, the state's leading organization in eviction prevention.

Santisimo Cuerpo y Sangre de Cristo

Es la fiesta del Cuerpo y la Sangre de Cristo, que celebra la presencia real de Jesucristo en la Eucaristía. En este día recordamos la institución de la Eucaristía durante la Última Cena, en el Jueves Santo, cuando Jesús convirtió el pan y el vino en su Cuerpo y su Sangre.

Cuando la Eucaristía se expone para la adoración de los fieles, se coloca en un recipiente sagrado llamado "Custodia". Esta sostiene la Hostia consagrada en un soporte de vidrio transparente que permite verla y adorarla.

El Santísimo Sacramento puede exponerse de distintas maneras: sobre el altar de una iglesia para la adoración y la oración; en devociones públicas, como la bendición eucarística; o en procesiones solemnes durante la fiesta de Corpus Christi y otras celebraciones.

Esta práctica comenzó en el siglo XIV y ha sido promovida por papas, concilios, y santos como una forma extraordinaria de expresar la suprema importancia de la Eucaristía y el amor que profesamos a Nuestro Señor.
