Having a stable place to call home is already making a meaningful difference.

Our mentors are visiting regularly, building relationships and working with Jazz on budgeting and financial goals. We're excited to share that she has secured a job in housekeeping and is interviewing for a remote customer service role as well — an important step forward for her growing family.

We also have encouraging news: a reliable used car has been identified at a very reasonable price. As Jazz settles into employment, we will work with her on an affordable payment plan that supports accountability and long-term independence.

And joyful news — she's expecting a baby boy in August!




