Stroke Scan Plus: Prevention is the Key to Good Health

Stroke Scan Plus and Centro Católico del Espíritu Santo will again host lifesaving preventive ultrasound screenings on Saturday, April 11, from 9:00 AM - 4:00 PM. These screenings detect early signs of serious conditions such as stroke risk, abdominal aneurysm, thyroid disease, and other internal health issues that are often not included in routine annual checkups and may not be covered by insurance without symptoms.

For \$179, you will receive 7 ultrasound screenings: Carotid (stroke risk), Abdominal Aorta (AAA), Thyroid, Liver, Kidneys, and Gallbladder. Blood testing is available for an additional cost. No insurance is required, and appointments are limited. Register in the Narthex after Mass this weekend or call 832-437-7355 to schedule an appointment. Screenings will take place in the classrooms beneath McDonough Hall.

Farewell, Marcia Palcher!

After nearly three decades of dedicated service, we bid a heartfelt farewell to Marcia Palcher as she enters retirement. A parishioner since 1990 and a member of our staff for 29 years, Marcia has served in our Stewardship Department supporting the parish offertory, the Archbishop's Annual Appeal, and capital campaigns to build the Church and the new McDonough Hall and Chapel.



Marcia also helped foster community at Holy Spirit by coordinating Wednesday Night Dinners and new parishioner dinners for many years. She served as a leader for the Supper Club, Help with Mailings, and the Person-to-Person ministries.

One of the most meaningful moments in Marcia's faith journey began in the 1990s when she responded to a plea for volunteers for the women's AIDS home, Gift of Grace, run by the Missionaries of Charity. After prayerful reflection, she volunteered for nearly ten years and had the blessing of meeting Mother Teresa during her visit to Atlanta.

Marcia and her husband John, who retired from the parish staff in October, often reflect on how blessed they have been that God guided them to this parish community. We thank Marcia for her faithful service and wish her many blessings in retirement.



British scholar and lay theologian C.S. Lewis (1898-1963), widely known for *The Chronicles of Narnia*, also wrote one of the most famous works of Christian satire: *The Screwtape Letters*. First published in 1942, the book presents a series of fictional letters from a senior devil, Screwtape, to his inexperienced nephew Wormwood, as he attempts to guide a human soul toward temptation. The work has inspired stage and musical adaptations and has even been quoted by former President Ronald Reagan.


