

and it affects all of us at one point or another. Unfortunately, we live in a society that does not like to acknowledge these events and expect us to be back to normal in a few short weeks. It's not possible.

inclement weather.)







## IMPORTANT PARKING INFORMATION



Holy Spirit Catholic Church employs police officers on Sunday mornings and during special events to help maximize our parking spaces and to ensure that the lots are always accessible to emergency vehicles, should

Founded in 1980 by Fr. John Harvey, OSFS, at the request of the late Terence Cardinal Cooke, it has since expanded to over 175 Courage chapters worldwide.

On November 28, 2016, Courage International, received canonical status in the Roman Catholic Church as a diocesan clerical public association of the faithful, making it the only canonically-approved apostolate of its kind.

#### 5 Goals of Courage

- 1. To live chaste lives in accordance with the Roman Catholic Church's teaching on homosexuality;
- 2. To dedicate our entire lives to Christ through service to others, spiritual reading, prayer, meditation, individual spiritual direction, frequent attendance at Mass, and the frequent reception of the sacraments of Reconciliation and Holy Eucharist;
- 3. To foster a spirit of fellowship in which we may share with one another our thoughts and experiences, and so ensure that no one will have to face the problems of homosexuality alone;
- 4. To be mindful of the truth that chaste friendships are not only possible but necessary in a chaste Christian life; and to encourage one another in forming and sustaining these friendships;
- 5. To live lives that may serve as good examples to others
